

BSH return to work day

Tuesday 9th June, 09.00-15.30

The popular BSH “return to work” day is running again in June 2026. The day is aimed at haematology SpRs and middle grade doctors returning to clinical practice in the UK after a break from clinical practice (e.g. PhD, maternity leave). The day has 2 purposes: a review of changes in practice across all areas of haematology, and rebuilding confidence in the ability to manage common and important clinical scenarios (with a focus on emergency management).
